



## MALAYSIA'S FIRST 100 MW SOLAR PROJECT

We're really excited to share that we have secured and started handling a new solar project. It's the first among the five 100 MW solar projects gazetted under the Energy Commission's Large Scale Solar Photovoltaic Plant 3.

This solar plant is located in the state of Kedah in the northern region of Peninsula Malaysia. Based on the procurement list, we will be handling almost **800 containers in approximately 5 months**. There are some conventional shipments for the oversized cargoes.

Having said that, it's also our first time handling a 100 MW project.

Our largest prior to this was 78 MW. The shipments are coming in via Penang Port and Port Klang. Our teams are all geared up to ensure timely coordination and deliveries. Thanks to our experience, we're confident of doing a good job like what we have done for all the earlier solar projects.





## DELIVERY & UNLOADING OF ESCALATOR TRUSSES FOR MRT 2

Earlier we shared that we are handling the import of 250 containers comprising escalators for the Klang Valley MRT 2 project. We are still receiving the containers in batches and storing the escalator trusses in our warehouse prior to delivery.

We have started sending specific trusses to the project sites based on the schedule provided. The delivery points are the 9 underground stations. Upon arrival at site, we work together with our associate Megalift to unload the trusses using mobile cranes. In some of the stations, we had to bring the trusses to a depth of almost 20 meters.

## REGULAR EXPORT OF PALM FIBER TO CHINA



One of our new clients exports big volume of palm fiber to China on a regular basis. Palm fiber is highly versatile and is used in the production of textiles,

household items and in some of the construction materials.



We handle the fiber in our warehouse, load them into containers and as part of the customs clearance requirement, we also assist our client in the export license application.
